



Inside Elections/NPI AZ-02 Public Opinion Poll

This poll was conducted by Noble Predictive Insights from Oct 10-12 and surveyed registered voters via text-to-online and live caller. In total, we interviewed 414 likely voters, determined via screening questions. The sample demographics were weighted to accurately reflect the projected 2024 electorate by gender, county, age, party registration, race/ethnicity, and education according to recent voter file data, the Arizona Secretary of State's Office, and recent Census data. The margin of error was +/- 4.8% for likely voters. Error due to non-response, survey design and other factors is not captured by sampling error calculations.

*Numbers may not total 100%, due to rounding.

Note: On Questions Q05a-Q08a, respondents who reported having already voted were presented with question verbiage that asked how they voted, rather than how they intend to vote. The response options were the same for all respondents. Exact question wording for those who already voted:

Q06b: Which of the following candidates for president did you vote for?

Q07b: Which of the following candidates for president did you vote for?
