

Inside Elections/NPI PA-08 Public Opinion Poll

This poll was conducted by Noble Predictive Insights from Oct 23-25, 2024 and surveyed registered voters in Pennsylvania's 8th district via text-to-online and live caller. In total, we interviewed 406 likely voters, determined via screening questions. The sample demographics were weighted to accurately reflect the projected electorate by gender, county, age, party registration, race/ethnicity, and education according to recent voter file data, the Pennsylvania Department of State, and recent Census data. The margin of error was +/- 4.9 % for likely voters. Error due to non-response, survey design and other factors is not captured by sampling error calculations.

*Numbers may not total 100%, due to rounding.

Note: On questions Q05a-Q09a, respondents who reported having already voted were presented with question verbiage that asked how they voted, rather than how they intend to vote. The response options were the same for all respondents. Exact question wording for those who already voted:

Q05a: Which of the following candidates for president would you have voted for, if these were the choices?

Q06a: Which of the following candidates for president did you vote for?

Q07a: Which of the following candidates for U.S. Senate would you have voted for, if these were the choices?

Q08a: Which of the following candidates for U.S. Senate did you vote for?

Q09a: Which of the following candidates for House of Representatives did you vote for?

Among those who responded "Not sure" on Q09a and had not reported already voting, we asked "If you had to decide today, which candidate would you vote for?" and replaced "Not sure" with "I would not vote." The results with leaners pushed in this way are reflected in Q09a_pushed
