

Inside Elections/NPI NC-01 Public Opinion Poll

This poll was conducted via text-to-online and live caller. The survey was completed by Noble Predictive Insights from September 24-30, 2024. We contacted a random sample of registered voters in North Carolina's 1st district using the voter file and determined likely voters via screening questions. The sample size was 404 likely general election voters. The sample was weighted by age, gender, ethnicity, subregion, education, and recalled vote to reflect the projected 2024 electorate. Numbers may not equal 100% due to rounding. The margin of error was +/-4.9%. Non-response, coverage error, and other factors may also contribute to error.

NOTE: Hurricane Helene hit North Carolina while this poll was in the field – dramatically lowering response rates, lengthening field time and potentially introducing novel forms of error that cannot be adjusted for using standard techniques.
