

Inside Elections/NPI OR-05 Public Opinion Poll

This poll was conducted via text-to-online and live caller. The survey was completed by Noble Predictive Insights from August 26-28, 2024. We contacted a random sample of registered voters in Oregon's 5th district using the voter file and determined likely voters via screening questions. The sample size was 419 likely general election voters. The sample was weighted by age, gender, ethnicity, county, education, and party to reflect the projected 2024 electorate. Numbers may not equal 100% due to rounding. The margin of error was +/- 4.8%. Non-response, coverage error, and other factors may also contribute to error.
